Scholarship Details

PURPOSE:

In order to carry on an educational and training program that encourages Ohio's rural youth to further their education and gives them an opportunity to become more aware of careers in the rural electric program, the PowerUP Technical scholarship award program is offered by North Western Electric Cooperative, Inc. (NWEC) and Ohio's Electric Cooperatives, Inc. (OEC).

SCHOLARSHIP AWARD:

One winner will receive a \$1,000 cash award each year. The award is non-renewable. The local winner will advance to the statewide level where they will compete for additional cash.

INTERVIEWS

In-person interviews will be held on March 6, 2024 at Defiance College and all eligible applicants are required to participate on that day in order to be considered for the scholarship award. Additional information will be mailed to the applicants prior to that date regarding specific interview times.

	One letter of recommendation The letter may be typed or handwritten and must be no longer than 500 words.				
	A recent photo of the applicant - A photocopy of a photo is acceptable.

Scholarship Rules

The following provisions will govern the acceptance of applicants for the PowerUP Technical Scholarship:

- Applicants must be a permanent <u>residential</u> NWEC member-owner, or a dependent child (son/daughter)/legal ward of a permanent residential member-owner, receiving service for the duration of the 2023-2024 academic year (August 2023 June 2024). Children/wards of NWEC <u>commercial</u> member-owners are not eligible unless one of their parents/legal guardians is also a permanent <u>residential</u> NWEC member-owner.
- 2. Applicants may be high school graduates enrolling in a technical program; current technical school enrollees or those enrolling in a post-undergraduate technical program. Applicants must plan to attend or currently attend an accredited technical school program.
- 3. Applicants must have a cumulative grade point average of <u>2.5 or above</u> on a 4.0 scale or an equivalent standing on a nontraditional scale.
- 4. Students may not be immediate family members of, or reside with, people who are employed by any electric cooperative in Ohio (employees, trustees, managers, OEC, or affiliated organizations such as Buckeye Power, Inc., RESCO, etc.).
- 5. Applicants who receive "full-ride" scholarships (i.e., scholarships that cover the cost of tuition, room, board and books) to the schools of their choice are not eligible for scholarships from NWEC or OEC.
- 6. All scholarships must be accepted in the first academic year after proof of enrollment is received by NWEC and OEC. However, an extension of one year may be granted for just cause in the judgment of the President/CEO of NWEC or of OEC. In the event students are unable to fulfill their enrollment obligation under this program, the awards are forfeited.
- 7. When selecting the annual winner, preference will be given to applicants who will be, or are currently, pursuing a career in an electrical related field of study.
- 8. These rules supersede all previous rules for this scholarship.
